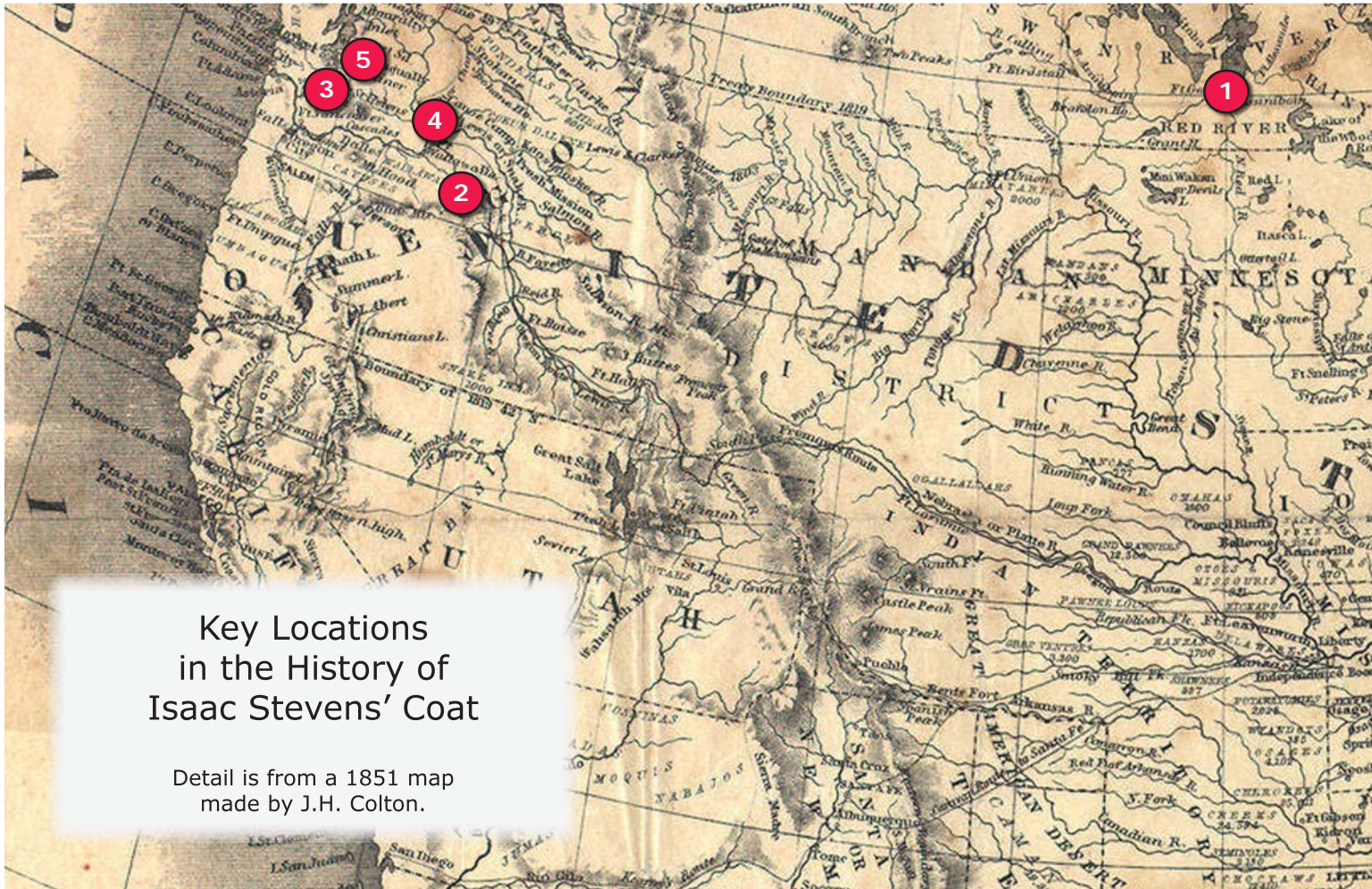


The Treaty Trail: U. S. - Indian Treaty Councils in the Northwest
