

A Select Timeline of Treaties

Between Nations



1713 Treaties of Utrecht

The Treaties of Utrecht were between France and Spain, on the one hand, and Great Britain, the United Provinces (Dutch Republic), and the Duchy of Savoy on the other.

1768 Treaty of Fort Stanwix

This treaty was between the Iroquois and the English.

1778 Treaty between the United States and France

This was a treaty of alliance.

1794 Pickering or Canadaiuga Treaty

One of the first post-Revolutionary War U.S.-Indian treaties between the United States and the Iroquois League of Six Nations.

Territorial Governor Isaac Stevens represents the U.S. government in a series of treaties designed to transfer vast areas of land out of the control of many Indian nations.



1854 Treaty of Medicine Creek

Signed on December 26, this treaty was between Isaac Stevens, Governor of Washington Territory, representing the United States and delegates from the Nisqually, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Squawskin, S'Homamish, Steh chass, T'Peeksin, Squi-aitl and Sa-heh-wamish tribes.

1855 Treaty with the Yakama

This treaty, signed on June 9, was between Isaac Stevens, Governor of Washington Territory, representing the United States and delegates from the Palouse, Pisquouse, Wenatshapam, Klikatat, Klinquit, Kow-was-say-ee, Li-ay-was, Skin-pah, Wish-ham, Shyiks, Ochechotes, Kah-milt-pay, and Se-ap-cat tribes.
